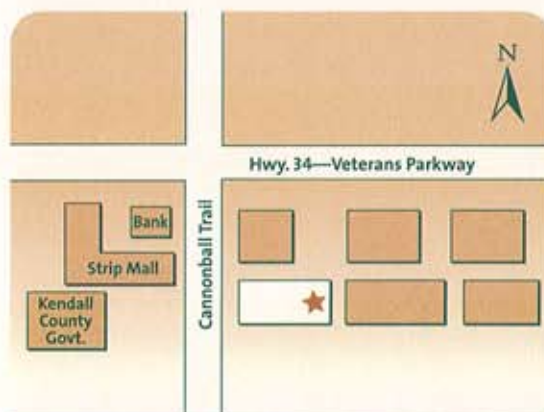

About Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery

Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery is a dental specialty, in much the same way that orthopedic surgery is a specialty of the medical profession. Oral surgeons complete an additional 4–6 years of hospital-based residency training beyond the four years of general dental training. As part of their specialty training, they study such diverse areas as anesthesia, head and neck surgery, pathology, trauma and general surgery.

In addition to their educational training, some oral surgeons choose to undergo a rigorous written and oral examination given by the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery to become Board certified and achieve Diplomate status.

Although Board certification is not required to practice oral and maxillofacial surgery, Dr. Kalant has completed these examinations and earned the distinction of board certification.

Dr. Don C. Kalant, Sr. received his Bachelor of Science degree in biology from the University of Illinois. He then received his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from Loyola University. He served his residency in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Loyola University Medical Center and Hines V.A. Medical Center. In addition to his private practice, Dr. Kalant holds a position of assistant clinical professor in the Section of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Loyola University Medical Center, where he is actively involved in resident education. He previously held the position of Assistant Chief of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Hines V.A. Medical Center.

Dr. Kalant is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and a Fellow of the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons. He has received Fellowship status in both the American and International Colleges of Dentists. He is also a member of both the Illinois and Chicago Societies for Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology. An active member of the American Dental Association, as well as the Illinois and Chicago Dental Societies, he has been a member of numerous committees and is past president of the West Suburban Branch of the Chicago Dental Society.
